If suspicious activities are noted, report it to Amtrak Police at (800) 331-0008, texting to APD11 from a smartphone or 27311 from a standard cell phone, or by calling 911.

Do not take any further action!

Restricted areas include but are not limited to the following: Platforms (ticketed passengers are exempt), Crew and Employee Work Areas, Maintenance Facilities, Unoccupied Trains and Engines, Office Areas, Employee Elevators, Baggage/Delivery Areas, Commissaries, Right-of-Way and Track Areas, In service train cars.
